YMCA's Parents As Teachers program services families with children ages birth to five; the program provides home visiting services to help children develop optimally during the crucial years of early life.

Healthy Families Mecklenburg serves families with children ages birth to three; the program provides home visiting to at-risk parents beginning prenatally to ensure healthy pregnancy and birth experiences.

All enrolled families are of low socioeconomic circumstances and struggle to meet their young child's basic needs. The program has identified 160 children (100 birth to three and 60 three to five)
